**Synonyms (words with similar meanings):**

Word	Synonym	Difference/Usage
Happy	Joyful	Both mean feeling pleasure, but 'joyful' suggests stronger, more visible happiness
Big	Large	Both mean great in size; 'big' is more informal, 'large' is more formal
Talk	Speak	Both mean to say words; 'talk' suggests conversation, 'speak' suggests giving information
Fast	Quick	Both mean rapid; 'fast' refers to speed/motion, 'quick' refers to short time duration
Smart	Intelligent	Both mean having good mental ability; 'smart' often includes practical cleverness

**Antonyms (words with opposite meanings):**

Word	Antonym	Difference/Usage
Happy	Sad	'Happy' means feeling pleasure; 'sad' means feeling sorrow or unhappiness
Big	Small	'Big' means large in size; 'small' means little in size
Fast	Slow	'Fast' means moving quickly; 'slow' means moving at a low speed



Hot	Cold	'Hot' means high temperature; 'cold' means low temperature
Rich	Poor	'Rich' means having much wealth; 'poor' means having little or no wealth

**Key Difference:** Synonyms are words that have similar meanings and can often be used interchangeably, while antonyms are words that have opposite meanings.
